Rotary is ultra-active in green issues

THE LATEST annual 'Clean Cyprus' project organised by the Rotary Club of Nicosia-Aspelia, has been concluded, the organisation said yesterday.

The programme's objective was to increase environmental awareness by encouraging re-cycling.

It was launched last September in collaboration with Green Dot, at the Presidential Palace, under the auspices of First lady Elsie Christofias,

The programme has now been finalised with the presentation of 26 waste paper bins, one for each class, to the 4th Aglantzia Primary School together with a large paper re-cycling bin.

An informative talk on re-cycling and composting by Loizos Afxentiou, of BLaRS (Business Links and Representation Services) was given. He also donated two composting bins to the school.

The organisation said that students had been encouraged to think seriously about the issues and had been invited to participate in an essay competition on the subject 'What would our town be in 20 years without recycling'.

A similar presentation of re-cycling materials will also be made to the English-language International School in Nicosia.

Each year Rotary Clubs all over the world undertake programmes and projects guided by the 'Four Avenues of Service': Community, Vocational, International and New Generation.

During Rotary Year 2010/11, now nearing its close, under the leadership of President Caterina Kalavas, RC of Nicosia-Aspelia implemented two very successful bi-communal projects aiming on raising awareness on Dyslexia as well as offering guidance to parents and teachers.

On the international front

the Club, in collaboration with the Cyprus Police-Traffic Dept., instigated a road safety campaign 'Drive left' aimed at drivers from overseas, whether tourists or residents. The club also adopted a child from Gaza.

Regarding the New Generation, the Club has an ongoing obligation: the Aspelia Scholarship Fund, a registered charity, which helps needy young people from Nicosia excelling in their studies.

Aspelia has also founded its own Rotaract and Interact Clubs. These are the youth sections of Rotary, through which young people are encouraged to take an interest in community work, service and volunteerism.
